Universeal Grout Haze Remover Universeal Grout Haze Remover effortlessly removes residues such as mortar and cement grout, grout film, efflorescence, encrusted and engrained dirt, as well as natural calcium & limescale deposits.

Universeal Grout Haze Remover can be used indoors and outdoors after the installation process or during construction. All surfaces must be acid-resistant surfaces such as ceramic tiles, porcelain, brick, clay and quarry tiles, terracotta, concrete and other types of natural stones. A milder solution of Grout Haze Remover will also clean grout, and works well on glazed ceramic tiles.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

- Dependent on degree of contamination, Universeal Grout Haze Remover can be used neat or diluted up to 1:10 with water.
- 2) Pre-wet the surface, apply generously and allow the product to dwell for 5-10 minutes before agitating with a scrub pad or similar and rinsing off with plenty of clean water.
- 3) Repeat the process if necessary, if using Universeal Grout Haze Remover indoors ensure good ventilation during and after use.
- 4) For stubborn staining and sealants/films that are problematic, we recommend Universeal Extreme Clean.
- 5) For the best possible results, always prepare your tiling and grouting project correctly and follow professional guidelines.

Please Note: Universeal Grout Haze Remover is not suitable for use with or around acid sensitive surfaces such as enamel, zinc, chrome, stainless steel. polished marble and limestone, etc. Always protect these areas and test the product in an inconspicuous area to determine suitability for intended use.
